1 Within board policy, the principal shall develop procedures for keeping school facilities safe and free
2 from hazards

3
4 All staff members shall report current and potential hazards to their immediate supervisors.

5
6 Each principal shall be responsible for the supervision of a safety program for his/her school. The
7 program shall include:

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9 1. Fire prevention
10 2. Accident prevention
11 3. Warning systems
12 4. Emergency drills (Fire, Tornado, and Earthquake)
13 5. Emergency closings
14 6. Traffic safety
15 7. Traffic and parking controls
16 8. Safety inspections
17 9. First Aid
18 10. Major emergency

19
20 Only students assigned to the school, the staff of the school, parents of students, and other persons with
21 lawful and valid business on the school premises shall enter onto the grounds or into the buildings of the
22 schools during the hours of student instruction. All staff members shall report all persons appearing to
23 be improperly on school premises to the principal.¹

24
25 The principal shall secure assistance from law enforcement officials when he/she deems it necessary in
26 order to maintain order or security during the school day or during extracurricular activities at school.

27
28 The use of trampolines shall not be permitted in any of the schools. The use of tumbling shall not be
29 permitted in any school, exclusive of supervised cheerleading activities.

30
31 No wooden exterior bleachers will be installed at any school.

32
33 Because of fire and electrical hazards, electric Christmas lights will not be permitted on natural and
34 aluminum trees.
