1 The transportation supervisor will be responsible for surveying all bus routes and scheduling bus
2 transportation.

3
4 Appeals of transportation decisions shall be made to the Director of Schools and the Board.

5
6 Students shall not be in transit to and from school more than one and one-half hours each way.²

7
8 Where practical, transfers may be made from one bus to another. Such transfers shall be with both buses
9 being present while the transfer is in process, unless the transfer point is a school campus. Leaving
10 students at home or place of business for transfer shall be permitted only after approval has been
11 obtained from the Board.

13 Bus routes shall not overlap unless necessary to reach some other portion of each respective route or
14 unless overlapping results from the necessity to travel the main highway to school centers. When more
15 than one bus travels a main highway and each bus picks up some students along such routes, each bus
16 shall be assigned a certain portion of the route and all students within this section shall ride the bus to
17 which assigned.

19 Once the official route is begun, stops (except for normal traffic stops, etc.) shall only be made to take
20 on, discharge or transfer students. Buses are not to stop at stores (or make any other non-designated
21 stops except for emergencies) when transporting students.

22
23 Buses will not go on private roads, and a bus route will not be extended to where a student lives within
24 one-fourth (1/4) of a mile or less of the regular established route.

25
26 Students who ride school buses shall attend the school designated except where the Board or Director
27 of Schools may designate an alternate school. If a parent chooses to send his/her child to another
28 school in the system, the parent must provide transportation to and from that school.
