POLITICAL ACTIVITIES

Employees may, on their own time, campaign for or against any candidate or referendum, but they shall not use the schools for political forum nor engage in any political promotion or solicitation during school hours. They are expected to assure that any statements made are a true, complete and accurate representation of factual situation. Noncompliance with these requirements shall be subject to disciplinary action.

Any employee who intends to campaign for an elective public office which infringes upon an employment agreement or work schedule shall present a proposed solution to the Director of schools for consideration. The essential element to be determined by the Director of schools is whether the activities proposed by the employee are consistent with services to the system and are in the best interest of children.

COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES

Employees have a right to express their views on any issue, but must in each case make clear that the view expressed is not the official view of the Board or the school system.
